



“P-tunes” is

- When pushing it with a hand, the air inside the pump is pushed out and the reed makes the sound.
- A set of 1 octave, 8 notes
- Place it on a desk etc. and push or hit the center of the top head to play.



- Push slowly makes a long sound, and push quickly makes a short sound, and push strongly makes a loud sound, and push weakly makes a little sound.
- Playable by attaching it to an arm or leg as a commercially available rubber or string can be put through the hole on the bottom surface.



- It can be developed into various games up to the ingenuity, such as putting through a string and tying it to a wire net.

Examples of how to make a sound

Let's make a sound

- Try pushing with the palm of the hand → Long sound !
- Try pushing with the fingertips → Short sound !
- Try pushing with one hand → Weak sound !
- Try pushing with both hands → Strong sound !

Examples of use

Peek-a-boo ! Found the same sound !

Objective: To develop the concentration and the sense of musical pitch

Note name to use: C/Do, D/Re, E/Mi, F/Fa, G/Sol, A/La, B/Si, C/Do x 2 sets Headcount: 1 person~ Recommended age: 3 years old~

- The teacher turns the MUSIC PUSH PUMP upside down and arranges them randomly so that the child can not see the note name sticker. The Child arranges in scale order in their normal direction.
- The teacher plays one MUSIC PUSH PUMP placed upside down.
- The child searches for and plays the MUSIC PUSH PUMP that sounds the same as the note that the teacher played.

Head, Shoulders, Knees, And Toes

Objective: While interlocking with each part of the body, familiarize with English and develop the mobility.

Note name to use C/Do, D/Re, E/Mi, F/Fa, G/Sol, A/La, B/Si, C/Do (Note is free choice from three 3 notes)

Headcount 1 person~

Recommended age 1 years old ~ (About when a child started to stand~)

1 Attach the MUSIC PUSH PUMP to each part of the body such as the palm, knee, and toe.

2 Let's sound the Music Push Pump attached to each part of the body matching the lyrics.

3 Once getting used to it, let's challenge by changing the speed, such as slowly for the first time, a little faster for the second time, and faster for the third time.

Music Pad MP-8
Chord Music Pad MP-6C

The MP-8 is a c1~c2, 1 octave, 8-note pad, and play by pushing or stepping on it. The relation between the note names and the colors, and the tones are the same as P-tunes. The MP-6C has the reeds that constitute the chord on each pad, and the chord sounds when playing in the same way as the MP-8. It is a 6-chords set of C / Dm / Em / F / G / Am. By using it together with P-tunes, you can further expand the sound play using your body.



Chords whistle
Accord ACC-01/ACC-02

ACC-01 is a set of whistle with three major chords C·F·G in Blue, Yellow and Red, and ACC-02 is a set of whistle with three minor chords Am·Dm·E in Light blue, Green and Pink distinguished by each color respectively, and it can be played the chord just by blowing it. It can be easily used for an accompaniment for P-tunes.
